> I appreciate your investigation regarding the safety of the Colchester to Middlebury NG pipeline recently built. It appears there are many construction violations that may undermine the stability of the pipeline now and in the years ahead. The pipeline has not been adequately supported below and around the pipe, not been secured properly and deeply enough in some areas, and not been properly treated for avoiding corrosive damage to the line. These neglected safety precautions are unacceptable. They do not reflect the agreement in the original Certificate of Public Good and do not give the appropriate level of safety to residents and businesses of Vermont.

> Please give a full and thorough investigation to all the points listed, including those the March 1st filing, and call a halt to further construction until the violations are physically remediated. Unless VGS makes good on their promise to Vermont, no further pipeline infrastructure should be constructed.

> Please continue to protect Vermont from a rushed and inadequate job.
