Dear PUC,
in the case (17-3550-INV) we know there is a multitude of known and suspected serious safety risks and problems. These are serious and a fine will not remedy them. Since you supposedly represent the interests and safety of the public, either demand that the construction issues be repaired, or reopen the entire CPG permit.
The NOPV case (18-0395-PET), and the currently pending CPG case for the Monkton Gate Station (17-4909-PET) should both be put on hold - no decisions made, no actions taken - UNTIL AND UNLESS the pending investigation case (17-3550-INV) has included and completed a thorough review of the broadened scope of safety violations - as requested by intervenors in their March 1 filing.
