Dear Commissioners,

Intervenors in case 17-3550 that VGS have compiled evidence that VGS has not always met safety and construction regulations in the Addison Natural Gas Project. Decisions involving the Notice of Probable Violation and a Certificate of Public Good for the Monkton Gate Station (18-0395-PET and 17-4909-PET) should be put aside until the February 28, 2018 motion filed by the intervenors is considered. It is my opinion that the need for a broad investigation is well-supported in that motion, and is the only sensible course given the track record of Vermont Gas Systems. Whether it was by inexperience, incompetence or bad faith, VGS has run rough shod over public interests since the project's inception. There is every reason to lack confidence in the safety and quality checks that have been conducted (or not) to date.
