Order Granting Department Motion to Stay Further Scheduling

On February 5, 2021, I issued an Order providing an initial schedule for the penalty phase of this proceeding. In that Order, I directed that Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. (“Vermont Gas”) file any motion for reconsideration of the January 29, 2021, Order issued in this proceeding by no later than February 26, 2021. I also requested that the parties file a proposed schedule for the penalty phase of this proceeding by no later than March 19, 2021.

On March 16, 2021, Vermont Gas filed notice of its intention to file a reply on March 26, 2021, to the parties’ responses to Vermont Gas’s motion for reconsideration filed on February 26, 2021.

On March 19, 2021, the Vermont Department of Public Service (“Department”) filed a motion requesting a stay in the scheduling of the penalty phase of this proceeding representing that the other parties have no objection to this motion.

In this Order, I grant the Department’s motion and stay the scheduling of the penalty phase of this proceeding until after the Vermont Public Utility Commission issues a ruling responding to Vermont Gas’s motion for reconsideration.
