**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO REFILE PETITION**

On November 27, 2024, the Vermont Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) issued an order dismissing this petition without prejudice (“Order”) and requiring Vermont Gas Systems, Inc. (“VGS”) to refile the petition in accordance with the instructions in the Order by no later than December 27, 2024.

On December 3, 2024, VGS filed a motion seeking a two-week extension to the deadline to refile the petition, until January 10, 2025. VGS explained that the additional time is needed because VGS’s legal counsel is traveling out of the country from December 20, 2024, through January 3, 2025, for a long-planned trip that cannot be rescheduled without significant cost and inconvenience. VGS stated that, additionally, the two-week extension would allow VGS to comply with the Order without interruption to other scheduled employee vacation time during the holidays.




Based on the foregoing and because the request was timely,<sup>1</sup> the Commission finds good cause to grant VGS’s extension until January 10, 2025.


