TOWN OF VERNON REQUEST
FOR MODIFICATION TO THE APPROVED SCHEDULE

1. The Town of Vernon Planning & Development Commission (“Town”), by and through its attorneys, respectfully submits this motion requesting that the Commission adopt the following minor amendments to the schedule approved by the Commission on July 24, 2017:

Deadline for First Round Discovery Requests on Non-petitioners (<u>except the Town of Vernon</u>)	September 7, 2017
<u>Town of Vernon pre-files initial testimony</u>	<u>September 13, 2017</u>
Deposition Notices Due	September 14, 2017
<u>Deadline for First Round Discovery Requests on Town of Vernon</u>	<u>September 20, 2017</u>
Non-petitioners’ First Round Discovery Responses due	September 27, 2017 (October 6, 2017 for NEC)

2. This request is occasioned by the Town's very recent retention of the undersigned as legal counsel, the need to consider what other consultants might be required to assist, and the need to adequately review the voluminous materials that have been generated and prepare prefiled testimony.

3. On July 26, 2017, the undersigned sent an e-mail to all parties and counsel indicating its intention to file this motion.

4. The following parties responded by e-mail as follows:

- Entergy affirmatively stated its consent to the proposal (reserving its right to change its position if other parties also requested additional/other revisions to the schedule).
- The Department of Public Service, the Agency of Natural Resources, and the Attorney General's Office affirmatively stated their support for the request.
- The Windham Regional Commission, the Elnu Abenaki, the Conservation Law Foundation, the Missisquoi Abenaki, and the New England Coalition, all affirmatively stated that they do not oppose the request.

5. No party stated any opposition to the request.

6. No party requested additional changes to the schedule.

7. The Town therefore respectfully requests that the Commission, at its earliest convenience, grant the instant motion and adopt these minor schedule changes.
