NORTHSTAR’S RESPONSE TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION’S PROCEDURAL
ORDER DATED JANUARY 11, 2018


On January 11, 2018, the Public Utility Commission (PUC) issued a Protective Order for Prefiled Evidence. In this Order, the PUC declared that certain allegedly confidential information should be public and other confidential information would remain confidential for only 90 days after certain milestone events. The PUC has given joint petitioners two business days to request the PUC to reconsider the removal of any such information from seal if they so desire by making such request by January 16, 2018. NorthStar¹ respectfully requests that the PUC extend this deadline until January 18, 2018 to allow for an appropriate time to review of all the information that this Order affects. NorthStar will not have sufficient time to request reconsideration by Tuesday given that the PUC issued the Order when the State of Vermont was depositing NorthStar and Monday is a holiday. NorthStar would request that this extension also extend the deadline for

the Department of Public Service regarding its January 18, 2018 deadline for disclosing allegedly confidential information. Given the short turnaround time provided by the PUC, it is impossible to comply with the PUC's three-day request policy, and NorthStar hopes that the PUC will consider this request for extension as timely filed. NorthStar greatly appreciates the opportunity to explain why a two-year, rather than a 90-day period for disclosure of its financial information should apply, and that portions of Mr. Dane's prefiled testimony should remain confidential.
