JOINT PETITIONERS' RESPONSE TO MOTIONS FOR LEAVE TO INTERVENE  
BY NEW ENGLAND COALITION, INC., AND WINDHAM REGIONAL COMMISSION


Joint Petitioners NorthStar Decommissioning Holdings, LLC, NorthStar Group Holdings, LLC, LVI Parent Corp., NorthStar Group Services, Inc., NorthStar Nuclear Decommissioning Company, LLC (all NorthStar entities together, "NorthStar"), and Entergy Nuclear Vermont Investment Company, LLC ("ENVIC"), and Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. ("ENOI"), by their attorneys, respectfully submit this response to the January 27, 2017 motion of New England Coalition, Inc. ("NEC") and the February 3, 2017 motion of Windham Regional Commission ("WRC") requesting that the Vermont Public Service Board ("Board") grant them leave to intervene in this docket.

Joint Petitioners do not oppose the motions to intervene by NEC or WRC in this proceeding. However, Joint Petitioners wish to briefly comment on NEC's (at 1-2) and WRC's (at 1) reference to 30 V.S.A. § 248 factors. As the Chairman noted during the prehearing conference, the instant petition is not a Section 248 petition; instead it was filed under 30 V.S.A. §§ 107, 231, and 232. Although some Section 248 factors may be relevant to determining the

general good of the state by analogy, the petition need not meet the Section 248 criteria.
