IBEW Local 300's interest in the outcome of this proceeding cannot be protected in any other proceeding. In this docket, the Board will make determinations regarding the safety and wellbeing of the current and future employees of both Entergy Nuclear Vermont Yankee and NorthStar. Also included in the Board's determination, are the soundness of the proposed transfer of ownership, as well as the responsibility and management of the Vermont Yankee facility. This proceeding is the only opportunity for the IBEW Local 300 to provide input regarding these matters and how they affect the interests of the IBEW Local 300 members.

IBEW Local 300 has the ability and experience to effectively address the issues involved in this proceeding and the IBEW Local 300's intervention will not delay the proceeding or prejudice the interests of other parties.
